- a. Awesome opportunity for our students. In conjunction with Amazon.
- b. Our students are receiving scholarships to allow them to participate at no cost. The regular cost per student is \$200.
- c. We will have 2 sections. One on Tuesday and one on Wednesday. Each group will have one of our teachers as a facilitator and 16 students. Each section will have a live instructor via the internet.

9. Concerns from previous meeting:

- a. CVMS Participation Points-
 - i. Participation points are given daily to encourage regular attendance.
 - ii. All absences except school excused activities need to be made up.
 - 1. In attendance, a P or an E means that a parent called or came to pick up their student. A U means that there was no contact made to excuse a student. A D means that an excuse from a doctor, dentist, orthodontist, or other medical person was given to the office.
 - iii. CVMS is willing to raise the level of make up for participation days to 70%.
- b. ALEKS-
 - i. Math teacher have not had students complain about getting ahead
 - ii. Students have time at school one class day per week. They can also come in before school, during lunch, after school, and during after school homework class.
 - iii. Teachers believe that the benefits of utilizing ALEKS far outweigh the concerns.
- c. Trackers-
 - i. Teachers were surveyed to address specific concerns of Trackers / Aides.
 - 1. Teachers believe that the Trackers / Aides are a benefit to them. Those that did not want to utilize those services had the Tracker / Aide removed. After removal, some asked for them back because the help they provided to students was noticed.
 - 2. Marlene Fausett and Carma Galloway are hired through Trust Land monies. If we decide to use our funds another way, one or both of these Trackers are who we would lose.
 - ii. Adjustments were made in classes that Trackers / Aides attend and help in.

- i. We have tried to share information in more ways by utilizing ParentLink, Texts, Email, and sending the calendared items in mail correspondence.
- ii. We also keep our school calendar up-to-date.
