Students participating in extracurricular activities and parents,

At CVMS, we appreciate your hard work and extra time that you put in at practices, games, meets, and competitions. By working hard in your activities and your academics, you represent our school community well.

We want to make sure that each player / participant understands our extracurricular policy regarding eligibility to participate in extracurricular activities. Student athletes / participants represent all of us at Canyon View Middle School, and because of that, you have a greater responsibility. The school Academic Probation and Citizenship Probation policies are enforced with our extracurricular student participants. In addition, each extracurricular participant must have and maintain a minimum grade of C- in each class and may not have any N's or U's in citizenship.

Academic and citizenship grades are checked every Monday morning. If a student athlete has a class grade lower than a C- or an N or U in citizenship, on Monday, they will be ineligible to participate, sit on the bench, or travel with the team to the game, meet, or competition that week. Coaches are updated on student extracurricular participants and their academic and citizenship grades. Parents and students are able to check grades anytime through Aspire or the district app.

Student extracurricular participants are expected to attend practices while they are working to improve academic and citizenship grades that are below expectations.
